You will have a deeper sense of how your voice works, how to care for it, how to warm it up, and how to use it to its full capacity! You will get tips on how to structure your own practice, and how to express a lyric more meaningfully. Bring your questions and vocal concerns to this rich experiential workshop.

- Singing anatomy
- Mind-body connection in singing
- Vocal resonating
- Connecting different parts of the range
- Debunking singing myths
- Vocal interpretation
- The role of the nervous system in singing
